## Call to express interest in a visiting scholar position at the department of Economics at the University of Alcalá

The Department of Economics of the Universidad de Alcalá is looking for a research economist interested in pursuing their academic career in Alcalá de Henares. The initial contract will provide the candidate the opportunity to be part of the active research groups of the faculty and to enlarge the range of research topics and networks of the department. It will also give the visiting scholar time to obtain the accreditations required by the Spanish university system to opt for a tenure position in the future.

**Position:** Visiting scholar at the department of Economics (profesor visitante de Fundamentos del Análisis Económico).

Expected starting date: End of October or first week of November 2020.

**Duration of the contract:** The successful candidate will be offered an initial contract until August 31<sup>st</sup> 2021 renewable until the end of August 2022.

Salary: Annual gross wage: €34,742 in 14 payments of €2,481.

**Teaching duties:** The visiting scholar will have teaching responsibilities of as much as 240 hours per year in Macroeconomics and Microeconomics at undergraduate and graduate levels.

**Deadline to express interest in this call:** Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020.

## **REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION PROCESS:**

The candidate should be a PhD in Economics currently working or with a relevant recent experience in a non-Spanish university or research institute with a clear personal research focus on Macroeconomics and a proficiency level in English. Communication abilities in Spanish and previous teaching experience are not strictly required.

The selection process will be based upon research outcomes such as peer reviewed publications, participation in competitive research projects, ability to communicate in Spanish and teaching experience in Economics. After screening the expressions of interest received, some candidates will be interviewed in the second or third week of October.

The candidate selected by the department will be presented to the university's research and lecture appointment committee (Comisión de personal docente e investigador) for its final approval in the last week of October.
