# VENUE:

The conference will take place at the World Bank Headquarters in Washington DC, at **1818 H Street NW**. Registration will take place at the main entrance where our team will issue visitor passes. Conference participants need to bring a **passport or national identification** for the registration process but also for re-entry the following days.

# **POLICY CONFERENCE JULY 8:**

This one-day conference will take place on July 8 between 9.00am – 5.30pm and will be open to all participants of the ECINEQ conference.
